


OPERATIONAL PLAN PROGRESS

COLBY TENNIS CENTER GROUNDBREAKING

Colby Community College and its generous supporters celebrated the ground breaking of the 21,328 square-foot facility scheduled to open Fall 2021. The facility will have two collegiate tennis courts, two pickleball courts, and a walking track. It will be open 24 hours a day and accessible to the community. In partnership with its supporters, the College raised \$1,100,000 this year for the Tennis Center.

Expanding programs at Norton Correctional Facility

Along with offering adult education provided by the Colby Community College Adult Ed program, incarcerated individuals at the Norton Correctional Facility now have the opportunity to continue their education through the Alternative Energy program. Students who qualify will receive federal grant funding as a way to support their efforts in the program. The first cohort kicked off their first semester in Spring 2021.
