



Nursing Next Gen NCLEX Complete Exam Preparation Platform RFP

Overview and Background

Colby Community College is located in the northwest corner of Kansas, approximately 50 miles from the Colorado and Nebraska borders. The College was established in 1964; it is a dynamic institution of more than 2,400 students. In addition to a main campus of approximately 60 acres, CCC operates a 60-acre farm for students to use as a hands-on laboratory and training facility. CCC is seeking bids for a new feed wagon for their 60-acre farm.

Purpose

Colby Community College is seeking to purchase a Next Gen NCLEX complete exam preparation platform (described below) and invites vendors to submit a proposal for the purchase of such a product. This product will be used for up to 30 ADN students and up to 30 PN students. Please itemize costs per student for both ADN and PN students.

NOTE: Bidders must include the completed Bid Form (found at the end of this RFP) with their bid documents. Failure to include a completed Bid Form will disqualify the vendor from consideration.

Key professional areas must include Systems, Concepts, Exemplar/Diseases, Specialty, Nursing Process, NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN Client Needs, Quality and Safety for Nurses (QSEN), and Clinical Judgment Measurement Model.
