All sealed bids need to be finalized and turned in October 18, 2019 by 12:00 PM to Thomas Hall (CCC's Main Campus), attention: Nikol Nolan. These bids will be opened by the Vice President of Business Affairs, Dean of Student Affairs, and one staff member.

**Award Date:** The Board meeting will be held on October 21, 2019, to select a vendor. The selected vendor will be notified after approval has been received from the Board of Trustees.
