- **AG149 Principles of Animal Science is a prerequisite for VN123 Basic Nutrition.**
- **VN122 Anatomy and Physiology for Veterinary Nurses is a prerequisite or co-requisite for VN150 Veterinary Nursing Pharmacology I.**
- **VN122 Anatomy and Physiology for Veterinary Nurses is a prerequisite or co-requisite for VN134 Veterinary Immunology.**

All prerequisite and First and Second Term courses must be successfully completed with a “C” or better before a student accepted into the program may enroll in Third Term courses and above.

All prerequisite and program-specific coursework must be completed with a grade of "C" or better to meet prerequisite, co-requisite, and graduation requirements.
