



## The Colby Commitment Scholarship

As we look toward the 2020-2021 school year, Colby Community College remains committed to our students and their educational futures. With that in mind, CCC is introducing The Colby Commitment Scholarship. This new scholarship is open to all students (new and returning) enrolling for Fall 2020 at Colby Community College. Students are eligible to receive up to \$500 for enrolling as a full-time student at Colby Community College for the first time between July 20 and August 7. There are two separate parts of the scholarship: **Enrollment and Housing**. These scholarships are limited, so sign up today!

### Enrollment

All students who enroll for Fall 2020 between July 20 and August 7 will receive a \$250 scholarship (\$125 in the fall semester and \$125 in the spring 2021 semester). Students **MUST** maintain full-time status (12 or more credit hours each semester). ### Housing

All students who submit a housing contract, questionnaire, and \$175 deposit/contract fee between July 20 and August 7 will receive a \$250 scholarship (\$125 in the fall semester and \$125 the spring 2021 semester). All paperwork and payment must be received between July 20 and August 7 to be eligible. Documents are at <https://www.colbycc.edu/student-life/housing/forms/index.html>.

### Additional Information

The Colby Commitment award is for the 2020-2021 school year only. Students who do not meet the requirements mentioned above will be required to re-pay their scholarship. Students receiving the housing scholarship must enroll in a minimum of nine (9) hours of face-to-face classes to meet dorm requirements.

### Exclusions

The following are not eligible because of scholarship opportunities specific to their areas:

- Select admission programs (i.e., Nursing, PTA, Dental Hygienist, and Veterinary Nursing). However, students taking pre-requisites prior to acceptance to these programs **are** eligible.
- Students receiving performance-based scholarships for athletics/co-curricular activities are not eligible for the enrollment portion of the scholarship. However, they remain eligible for the housing piece provided they meet the above mentioned requirements.
