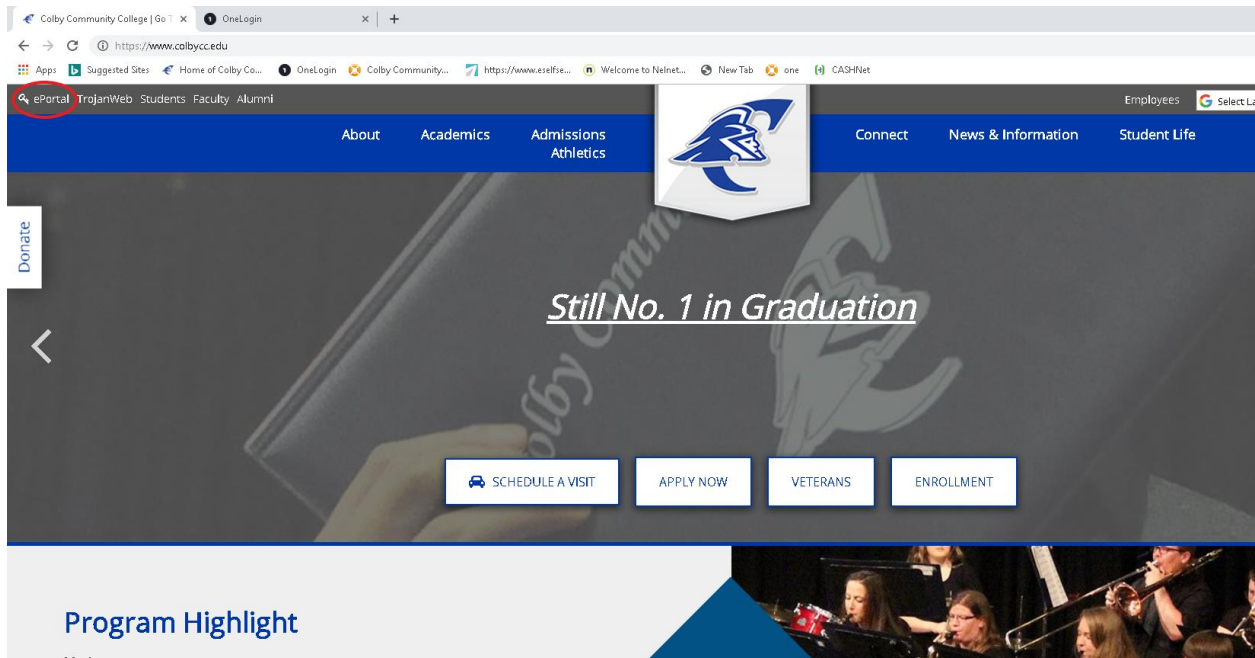
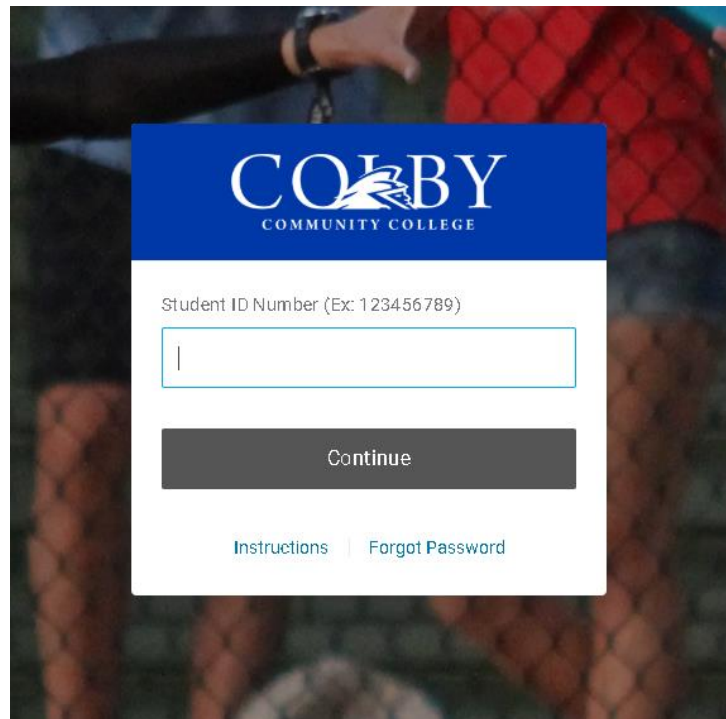


# Making a Payment




