

## **Next Gen NCLEX Complete Exam Preparation Platform RFP**

(Submission deadline is 12:00 p.m. on February 8, 2025)

## **Purpose**

Colby Community College is seeking to purchase a Next Gen NCLEX complete exam preparation platform (described below) and invites vendors to submit a proposal for the purchase of such a product. This product will be used for up to 30 ADN students and up to 40 PN students. Please itemize costs per student for both ADN and PN students.

NOTE: Bidders must include the completed Bid Form (at the end of this RFP) with their bid documents. Failure to include a completed Bid Form will disqualify the vendor from consideration.

#### Overview

The specifications of the Next Gen NCLEX complete exam preparation platform are listed below:

- ADN and PN Clinical Judgement Exams with focus areas of Fundamentals, Pediatrics, Women's Health, Community Health, Pharmacology, Medical-Surgical, Mental Health, Health Assessment, Leadership, Nutrition, Research, Maternal-Child, Medical-Surgical II, and Pathophysiology. Key professional areas must include Systems, Concepts, Exemplar/Diseases, Specialty, Nursing Process, NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN Client Needs, Quality and Safety for Nurses (QSEN), and Clinical Judgment Measurement Model.
- Content modules specific to most aspects of nursing, including but not limited to Dosage Calculations, Safe Medication Administration, Health Assessment, Fundamentals of Nursing Profession, Electronic Medical Record introduction, Community and Public Health, Mental Health, Clinical Decision Making, Clinical Scenarios, Maternal Newborn Nursing Practice, Nursing Care of Children, Leadership and Management, Civility in Nursing Practice, Video Case Studies, Professional Communication, Wellness and Self Care.
- Virtual sessions at the end of Fundamentals to help students develop habits for studying that promote Clinical Judgment. Must include Clinical Judgment test items, patient-care activities, and Next Gen toolbox activities. Virtual sessions in the final term for Practice

Readiness and NCLEX prep. Must include Clinical Judgment test items, patient-care activities, and Next Gen toolbox activities.

- A bank of Next Gen questions and EHRS. Must include full reporting, remediation for testing, and randomized experiences with EHR based on the evidence-base from NCSBN's CJMM.
- Conceptual clinical cases and resources that can be used in lecture, simulation, lab, or a post-conference activity. It must include patient-centered care, professionalism and leadership, teamwork and collaboration, evidence-based practice, informatics, safety and quality improvement, and communication.
- NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN Next Gen review guide based on studying from the
  perspective of a nurse, helping students conceptually synthesize and prioritize everything
  learned.
- Resources for faculty training, use of product, curriculum development, and integration.
- Availability of live review session taught by vendor-provided faculty.
