Transferability of Courses

The Kansas Board of Regents has approved 56 courses for guaranteed transfer among all Kansas public postsecondary institutions. A student in pursuit of a degree or credential who completes these courses at any Kansas public community college, technical college, or university can be certain the course transfers to any other public institution in Kansas. Kansas Board of Regents Policy on Concurrent Enrollment Partnership (CEP)

Definition of Concurrent Enrollment

A Concurrent Enrollment Partnership student is one who is enrolled in classes at a high school where approved high school instructors teach college credit classes during the normal school day. The student is also in grades 10, 11 or 12, or a gifted student in grade 9 with an Individualized Educational Plan (IEP) recommending college experience.
